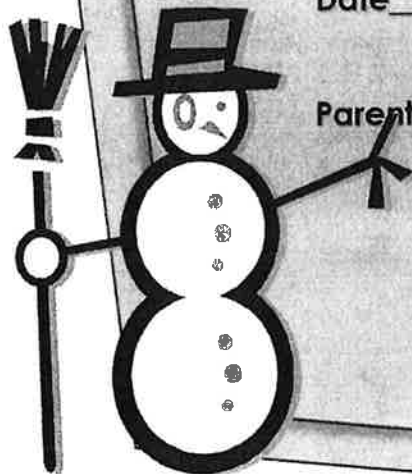

FIRST GRADE

Materials: Paper, pencils, crayons or markers

*Packet will be evaluated by the teacher through rubrics, correct responses, and creativity.

READING: Read a fictional story then list the title, author, characters, and one sentence telling the setting of the story. Then write two sentences telling what the book was about and draw a picture of your favorite part. (Approx. 30 minutes)

WRITING: Compose a list of sentences using your spelling words (this week's list or last week's list if you haven't received the new one). Make two of the sentences asking questions that require question marks and make two of the sentences telling sentences that require periods. Then create a sentence using two or more spelling words. (Approx. 15 minutes)

MATH: Create 5 math story problems that are either adding or subtracting. Then solve the problems to provide the answers to each of the story problems. You may include pictures with your story problems to help you solve it. Show your work. Then create 1 story problem for a classmate to solve: you do not have to solve this problem, but the problem has to be one that a classmate could solve. (Approx. 30 minutes)

SOCIAL STUDIES: Draw and label a map of your house. Include important rooms such as the kitchen, bedrooms, living room, and bathrooms. Then design your dream house and label it with the appropriate labels. BE CREATIVE! (Approx. 30 minutes)

SCIENCE: Draw and label the four seasons on a piece of paper that is divided into four sections. Compare and Contrast the weather (ex. temperature, rain, snow, sun), the clothes you wear (ex. scarf, jacket, shorts), and what you do (ex. building a snowman, plant flowers). Then write two or more sentences to tell which season is your favorite season and why. (Approx. 30 minutes)
