### Day 4

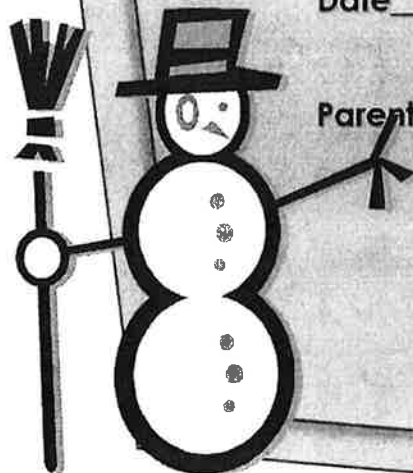
