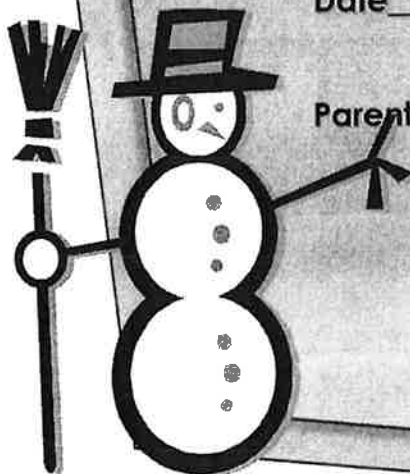

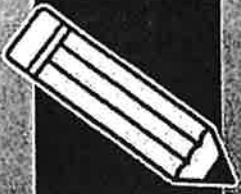
Do a Pyramid Spelling Sort using your spelling words. Write your spelling words starting with the first letter, then building up one letter every line underneath it until the entire word is written.
