### Day 2

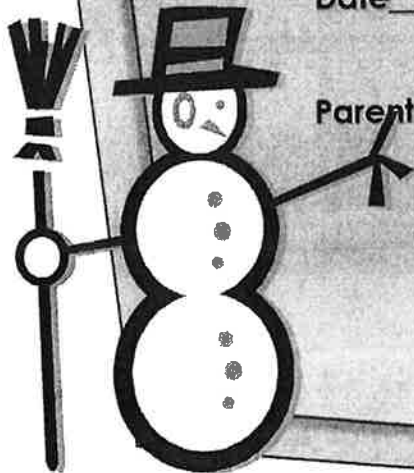

4. Choose five items from around your house. Line them up in order from shortest to longest. Draw a picture of the items in their correct order.

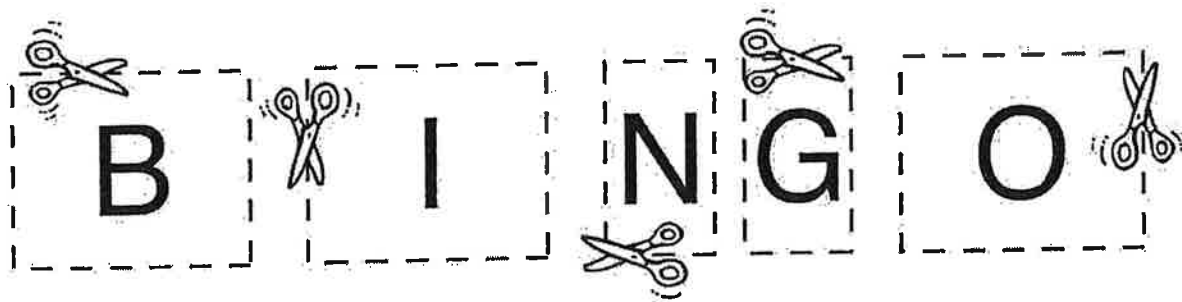
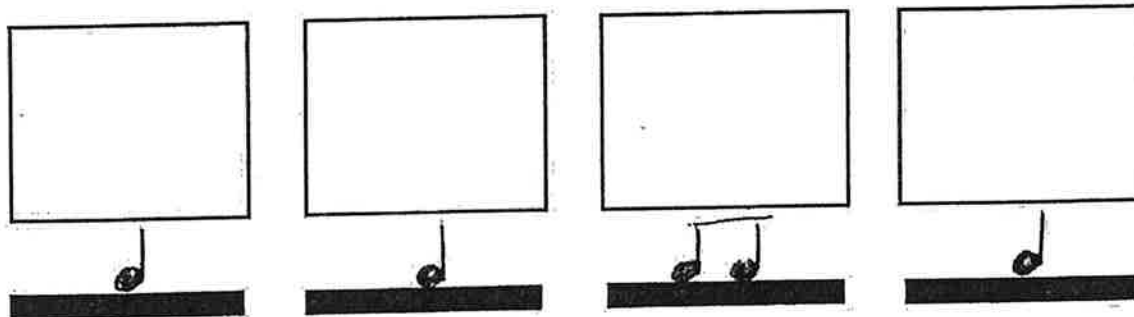
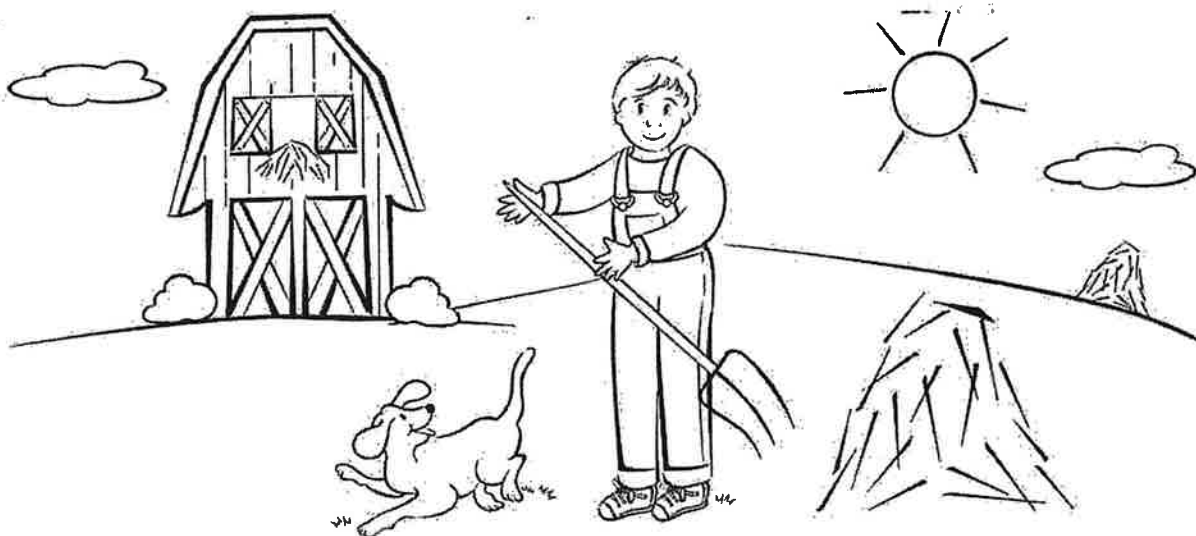
