

Hampshire County Schools

Project Description

1. New North Elementary School - construct and equip a new elementary school to house approximately 246 students in grades Pre-kindergarten thru 5th grades. Without limitations, site is to be located on existing property owned by the Hampshire County Board of Education and adjacent to the existing Slanesville Elementary School. (No Alternate Site)
2. New Central Elementary School - construct and equip a new elementary school to house approximately 384 students in grades Pre-kindergarten thru 5th grades. The site is to be located on property next to the current Augusta Elementary School. (Alternate Site on the existing Augusta Elementary School Property)
3. New West Elementary School - construct and equip a new elementary school to house approximately 460 students in grades Pre-kindergarten thru 5th grades. The site is to be located on the old Hampshire Memorial Hospital site as well as adjoining parcels in Romney, WV. (Alternate Site on the existing Romney Elementary School Property)
4. Existing Capon Bridge Elementary School - construct a gym with seating to accommodate basketball, volleyball and other gym activities.
5. Hampshire Senior High School renovations including without limitations safety and security upgrades, selected restroom renovations, correction of water infiltration issues and selected façade upgrades.
6. Demolition and/or disposal cost of the existing elementary schools that are being consolidated into the three new elementary schools.
7. Energy Savings Contract Projects (approximate) – LED lighting renovations, selected HVAC systems and control upgrades.
