#### Arrival

- Staff and students enter the main building (use front & back doors only)
- Hand sanitizer stations located at main doors (front & back).
- Extra disposal masks available at main doors (front & back).
- Daily temperature station for staff outside of main office (complete self-assessment online each Monday morning).
- Students report directly to their assigned area.
  - 12<sup>th</sup> = main cafeteria
  - 11<sup>th</sup> = main gym (home side bleachers)
  - 10<sup>th</sup> = main gym (visitor side bleachers)
  - 9<sup>th</sup> = auditorium
- Dismiss students to report directly to 1st block by grade level.
- Students complete daily wellness checks at start of 1st block (online).
- Breakfast will be served to classrooms at the end of 1st block.

# Hallways (Class Transitions)

- Stay to the right side of the hallways and stairways at all times.
- Staff in hallways and teachers at their doorway.
- No lockers are to be used.
- No water fountains are to be used. Water stations will be available at various locations. Students and staff are encouraged to bring their own water bottles.

# Stairway

Main Hallway Stairways...

- Middle of Hallway Stairway = **Down Only!** 2<sup>nd</sup> floor goes down
- End of Hallway Stairway = Up Only!1st floor goes up

# Classrooms (Instructional Time)

- Teachers greet students at their doorways.
- Hand sanitizer stations in each classroom
  - Including the gym, cafeteria, library, auditorium, weight room, etc.
- Students are not allowed to leave class during instructional time.
  - Except for restrooms.
  - Emergency situation = contact appropriate staff (nurse, counselor, admin, etc.).
- Teachers are expected to set up daily routines to provide a safe learning environment and to help clean up areas of the classroom.
- Teachers are encouraged to take their classes outside if appropriate.

#### Restrooms

- Hall pass from teacher
  - Student must sign-in/out (time).
  - Hall pass will be on colored paper so it is visible.
- Students are to use the restroom closest to their current class.
- Students are expected to return to class in a timely manner.
- Students are encouraged to use the restrooms during their assigned lunch shift to reduce the traffic during 3<sup>rd</sup> block.

#### Lunches

- Allow seniors to leave for their lunch shift 2 minutes earlier than others.
- Locations
  - 12<sup>th</sup> = library and courtyard (between auditorium and gym).
  - 11<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, & 9<sup>th</sup> = main cafeteria and patio.
- Water cooler and hand sanitizer stations at each lunch area.
- Students will not be allowed to leave the cafeteria during their lunch shift to visit teachers.
- Students will be dismissed by sections in the main cafeteria.

#### Dismissal

- Allow seniors to be dismissed 2 minutes before bell.
- Main exit doors propped open during dismissal (front and back).

# After School Opportunities

- All students staying after school must be under the direct supervision of a staff member at all times.

### Visitors

- Must stay in the Common area.
- Former students will not be allowed to visit during this time.
