This gilt was a solid member of the 2011 Premier Exhibitor herd at the Keystone International Livestock Show in Harrisburg, PA. Her littermates stood 2nd and 4th in the competitive February class. To promote a solid outcross the gilt is serviced to “Torge” the popular and successful boar at Conover Show Pigs for a March 6th litter.

The Hampshire High School Animal and Veterinary Science program has taken an active approach to the learning process by establishing an American Berkshire breeding herd. Our Berkshire program began in 2008 with the purchase of a bred female from the James Parlett family at the PA Farm Show. The sow delivered in a farrowing crate in the school shop. Our 6 sow unit, features bloodlines from such pedigrees as Legend, Timber, Sugar Daddy, Kaboom, US History, and Black Bull to name a few.
